DR. WAITE TEACHES CHINESE STUDENTS IN NORTH JERSEY

Seems like we have been gone from home more than usual of late. Not that that is all bad! NO!

It is fun to be with people, to learn to know them, and to discuss things concerning the Lord, the Bible, and textual matters. Not only do they often learn from my husband-and sometimes even from me-but we learn so much from them!

GNOSTICISM FOUND IN THE CHINESE UNION BIBLE VERSION

Recently Dr. Waite (my husband of sixty-four and a half years) taught at the EVANGELICAL BIBLE INSTITUTE in TOWACO, NEW JERSEY. He was there this past JANUARY, 2013, for five days of intensive instruction, showing the influence of Gnosticism on Bible versions, as well as other omissions and additions to their Bible's texts. Then in FEBRUARY, Dr. Waite taught the books of I & II CHRONICLES for another intensive five days, as well as wrapping up some unfinished comparisons of the textual omissions and additions showing the influence of GNOSTICISM in their Chinese Union Version (CUV) Bible. This group of about eighteen students were especially interested in the flaws in their CHINESE UNION VERISON (CUV), They were Chinese-speaking people from seven different countries such as Taiwan, Hong Kong, the Netherlands, Spain, Mainland China, and Japan.

SPEAKING WITH AN INTERPRETER

Not only was the subject of interest to his Chinese students, but also the fact that Dr. Waite spoke with an interpreter, was fascinating. He has this teaching on three disks, if you are interested (BFT #4053/1-3 @ \$30.00 + \$7.00 S&H). The interpreter during the January sessions was EUNICE LIM, a gifted woman in turning my husband's English into Chinese and vice versa. The interpreter for the February

classes was one of the students named Jane. She added spice to the translation with her own ideas and comments. Later, one of the students told me that MANDARIN Chinese was spoken there in the classes.

GNOSTICS' TEXT TAMPERING

My husband took 184 pages of some of the corrupted Bible verses done by translators who were influenced by the GNOSTICS' text-tampering, and put them in a copy-machine book format for the Chinese students to use during classes. Those 356 verses came from a book called *EARLY MANUSCRIPT, CHURCH FATHERS, AND THE AUTHORIZED VERSION WITH MANUSCRIPT DIGESTS AND SUMMARIES* (BFT #3230 @ \$20.00 + \$8.00 S&H) by one of our church's missionaries, and our friend, **Dr. J. A. Moorman**, a missionary-scholar in Great Britain.

MRS. MOSER'S BRILLIANT RESEARCH

MRS. JANET MOSER, who is now "present with the Lord" (2 Corinthians 5:8). did much research on the GNOSTICISM ISSUE that influenced the Bible version problems that we have today. How well I remember the afternoon she came from Michigan to our house here in Collingswood with a mutual friend from our area of South Jersey. Mrs. Moser was filled with knowledge, research, and dedication concerning the corrupt methods that the GNOSTICS used to tarnish the Words of God. Mrs. Moser was a sick woman who filled her last days and hours with such studies. She wanted no public praise or accolades for her work.

MRS. MOSER INVITED TO SPEAK TO DBS WOMEN

I remember the time that THE DEAN BURGON SOCIETY met in Grayling, Michigan–I think it was. I invited Janet to speak to the DBS WOMEN. I thought she might be able to do this, as we were in her home-state, and she was not that far from us. She said that she would speak to the men but not the women. She felt the women would not know what she was talking about, nor–she thought–would they be interested in the subject. I was sorry, for I have tried since the formation of THE DBS WOMEN to inform the women on such matters. We women are not dumb. (After all, she was a woman and she had learned all this.) The fact was that the men had their own speeches and the Society did not have a place for her to speak since their speaking roster was full. SO we never ever heard her speak on this important subject.

I remember when I invited a certain man named MICHAEL MAYNARD, with whom I had corresponded when he was lonely doing his research on the Johannine comma (I John 5:7-8) in Germany (I believe it was). I asked him to present his material to us women when the DBS was in Cedarville, Illinois. As it turned out, that talk became very informative and popular. It was requested by scholars to be reprinted for the public to read–ALL BECAUSE HE SPOKE TO US DBS WOMEN!

GNOSTICS ARE WITH US TODAY

My husband tells me that Alexandria, Egypt, was also the headquarters of the Gnostics and their

doctrinal heresies. The Vatican and Sinai Manuscripts (also originating in Alexandria, Egypt) are the basis of all modern Bible versions and are filled with Gnostic heresies. He reminded me, "*Gnostics are still with us today*!" According to the GNOSTICS, the PLACE and HEADQUARTERS of the true church and God's temple is in Alexandria, Egypt. (Page 212 in Mrs. Moser's book, **GNOSTICISM: THE DOCTRINAL FOUNDATION OF THE NEW BIBLE VERSIONS** [BFT #2732, 235 LARGE PAGES @ \$24.00 + \$8.00 S&H])

GNOSTIC TEACHINGS ARE DANGEROUS

I read from one of Dr. Waite's papers that he has listed twenty-four of the many important Gnostic Doctrinal Heresies. All these heresies, and many others, are found in the UBS and Nestle/Aland GNOSTIC CRITICAL GREEK TEXTS OF THE NEW TESTAMENT. He told the students there in North Jersey, "Since most New Testaments in all the languages of the world follow these GNOSTIC CRITICAL GREEK TEXTS, most, if not all, of these heresies are found in the modern New Testament translations such as the NASV, NIV, RSV, NRSV, ESV, and others." I've come to the conclusion myself that these GNOSTIC TEACHINGS are craftily insidious and deadly dangerous indeed!

GNOSTIC CHANGES FOUND IN MODERN TRANSLATIONS

I wish I had room and you had time to go over these important twenty-four GNOSTIC changes found in the translations some of us hold in our hands today. The Chinese students were fascinated by this information. As they compared the changes found in their own Chinese Union Version, they were mystified why many of such perversions

were found in their own Chinese Bibles! A few of the changes are as follows:

- Jesus had a sin nature like every other man.
- God had a fallen nature
- The "Christ" is separate from "Jesus."
- Joseph, not God, was the father of Jesus
- LUCIFER is the Savior.
- Man is saved by the symbolic death of Christ within man, not by the blood of Christ
- The Devil is an instrument of God and will ultimately be pardoned.
- The Christ was a created being and therefore had a beginning in time.
- Man is saved through sacraments.
- Man is saved through faith in his own works, not that of Christ's

A NAVY CHAPLAIN TAUGHT GNOSTICISM IN CORPUS CHRISTI

I REMEMBER, AS A NAVY CHAPLAIN'S WIFE-I think it was in Corpus Christi, Texas, at the Naval air station base chapel, one of the chaplains taught the strangest doctrine. I think I remember that he was a Methodist. Now, after hearing my husband teach several times on the influence of GNOSTICISM on Bible translations, I have come to realize that that chaplain, who taught that "Christ was separate from Jesus" and "that THE CHRIST came upon Jesus at his baptism in order to enlighten and perfect him and left him before he died," was influenced by GNOSTICS' teachings. Perhaps he didn't even know it.

I remember, as if it were yesterday, how that Navy chaplain went on and on explaining that Jesus did not know He was THE CHRIST until the baptism. WHAT FALSE DOCTRINE! Even I could detect such apostasy!

DR. WAITE NEVER WAS TAUGHT ABOUT THE TWO GREEK TEXTS IN SEMINARY

That experience of hearing bold, cold GNOSTICISM was long before my husband knew anything about the two opposite Bible Greek texts (the TEXTUS RECEPTUS & the WESTCOTT & HORT-TYPE Gnostic Critical Greek Text). Probably, I didn't even know what the word, GNOSTICISM meant in those days. I remember in seminary, that my husband never heard a thing about the Textus Receptus. He never was taught that the King James Bible was from that Greek Text and that the REVISED STANDARD VERSION, that would soon cause such an upheaval in the fundamental Christian world, would be translated from a different original text which we now know as the GNOSTIC CRITICAL TEXT used by the UBS and Westcott and Hort.

BURGON DEFENDED THE TEXTUS RECEPTUS "AS IT STANDS"

The AUTHORIZED KING JAMES BIBLE was translated from the Textus RECEPTUS not the GNOSTIC CRITICAL GREEK TEXT. The TEXTUS RECEPTUS was the text that DEAN JOHN WILLIAM BURGON defended back in the late 1800's. Some say Dean Burgon did not support the "TR." According to my husband, this is not true. Dr. Waite quotes John William Burgon in saying that the Textus Receptus "is an excellent Text as it stands, and that the use of it will never lead critical students of Scripture seriously astray." (*The Revision Revised*, by Dean John William Burgon, p. 269)

FIVE PENSIVE & PERTINENT CHAPTERS

The book is not a long volume-one hundred and eight pages with an extensive index. It contains five chapters, "BIBLE INSPIRATION," "BIBLE CORRUPTION," "BIBLE PRESERVATION," and "BIBLE TRANSLATION" as well as two APPENDICES (A & B). They are easily read and informative. For instance, the author spends some time explaining the meaning of the words "GIVEN BY INSPIRATION OF GOD" (theopneustos) found in 2 Timothy 3:16-17. In this chapter, he quotes men such as Dr. Jack Moorman, Dr. Floyd Jones, Dr. Jeffery Khoo, Southern Baptist Basil Manly, Jr., Dean John Burgon, Dr. Frederick H. A. Scrivener, and Dr. D. A. Waite, as well as the *Baptist Bulletin*, and the Dean Burgon Society (of which Dr. Bennett is an Executive Committee Member). I have read a few of the books on this subject-proofreading etc., and I found this one very interesting with "updated" quotes from modern men from the span of my own lifetime.

RECENT SCHOLARS QUOTED

Some of those scholars are quoted, such as WILLIAMS COMBS of Detroit Baptist Theological Seminary in Allen Park, Michigan. Dallas Theological Seminary's (my husband's school under Dr. Chafer) DANIEL WALLACE is often quoted as well as EDWARD HILLS and Kenneth Barker of NIV fame. Edwin H. Palmer and BRUCE METZGER are also quoted, as well as others.

DR. WAITE QUOTED FAVORABLY

Personally, I was very interested how my husband's work in his defense of the King James Bible and its underlying Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek texts is making an impact in this anti-King James Bible/Textus receptus world. Dr. Bennett quoted a man by the name of **DR. JEFF STRAUB** who wrote an extensive review of another article for the July 2011 *BAPTIST BULLETIN.* It was titled "HOW A TRANSLATION BECAME A LITMUS TEST FOR THEOLOGY." It was written in celebration of the 400th anniversary of the AUTHORIZED VERSION of THE KING JAMES VERSION OF THE BIBLE. From what I found on the internet, Dr. Jeff Straub is a professor of Historical and Systematic Theology at Central Baptist Seminary and other theological schools and endeavors. (I had never heard of him, but that isn't anything, because for the most part, I have been out of the "loop"–so to speak.)

DR. WAITE'S TONE WAS SCHOLARLY

DR. STRAUB quoted a 1979 "BAPTIST BULLETIN" article of my husband:

"The KIV is was advated by DA Wite diatr of The Bite for Tadymisty and "menter of a GAPBC duch Heath" in Define of the New Test menter of a GAPBC pastors, but his tone was respectful and scholarly." (Underlining mine)

*At the time Dr. Waite was a member of a GARBC church. Now he is the pastor of The Bible for Today Baptist Church here in Collingswood, NJ, which is completely independent.

**At the time of this article's writing, the term, "MAJORITY TEXT" was a name for the Greek New Testament Words underlying the King James Bible. In the 1980's it took on a completely different meaning.

Now in 2013, since the writing of the above mentioned article, what is called the "MAJORITY TEXT" is separate and distinct from the Textus Receptus underlying the King James Bible. The present "Majority Text" differs from the TR that underlies the King James Bible in 1500 to 1800 places. (Of interest--my husband tells me that there are now three so-called "Majority Texts": (1) the Hodges and Farstad Text, (2) the Robinson and Pierpont Text, and (3) the Norman Pickering Text.

We should not become confused because there are several Textus Receptus Greek Texts. My husband just told me that some people say there are ten or fifteen different editions of the TR. I did not know this myself until recently—but I am not the scholar! It should be pointed out that the DEAN BURGON SOCIETY, as well as the BIBLE FOR TODAY MINISTRIES, defend the Greek Words of that Textus Receptus Greek that underlie the King James Bible.

DAW: ONE OF THE MORE EDUCATED MEN IN FUNDAMENTALISM

Dr. Straub, according to Dr. Bennett, mentions DR. WAITE a couple of times in his Baptist Bulletin article:
