DR. WAITE PRESENTS

THE PROPER GREEK & HEBREW WORDS WHEN HE TEACHES

Sometimes it seems like all we have been doing of late is packing our suitcases, jumping into a car, or sitting on a plane and going off to meetings! Not that that isn't good! Yes it is. **It is always a pleasure for my husband, Dr. D. A. Waite, to go into churches or colleges to present the truth concerning the RECEIVED GREEK TEXT, the HEBREW TEXT, and the ARAMAIC TEXT from which the King James Bible is translated.** Many people do not realize that it isn't the translation that is inspired of God (II Timothy 3:16-17); **it is the original Words that were God-breathed.** And it has to be the **proper** ORIGINAL WORDS—not spurious words. Now, because those original Words are not with us today, the translators translate from *copies* of those original Words, **copies** of the inspired Words. *That's how it is and that's how it will probably always be unless some **actual** "original" from the pen of Paul or Moses shows up!*

THE ORIGINAL WORDS DO MATTER

We here at THE BIBLE FOR TODAY say those *Words* are the HEBREW, ARAMAIC, and RECEIVED GREEK WORDS that underlie our King James Bible! There is a teaching today that says that **TRANSLATIONS** are "*inspired*" or "*God-breathed*" and that it does not matter a bit concerning the original Words. Of course, this is not true. The original Words do matter! **Any proper translation should be based on an accurate translation of the original God-breathed language!**

THE TEXTUS RECEPTUS OR THE MAJORITY TEXT—WHICH?

There is a Bible School/Seminary that is being started soon in Pennsylvania. I believe it is this autumn of 2013, if I remember. The literature promoting this school says that they are going to use the MAJORITY TEXT. Back when my husband first defended the King James Bible and its underlying Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek Words, when someone talked about the **MAJORITY TEXT**, he meant the **TEXTUS RECEPTUS** (*the RECEIVED TEXT*). It was a hyphenated word (*the Majority Text—Textus Receptus*). **It was considered one Greek text. As the years went by, those two titles—separated, so now they are two different texts that differ in over 1500-1800 places.** I just wanted you to be aware of this. So, with this new school starting and their literature declaring they are to be a MAJORITY TEXT SCHOOL, my husband wrote to one of the founders (who had been one of the founders of the Dean Burgon Society 35 years ago) inquiring what was meant by his "MAJORITY TEXT"? In fact, my husband wrote him an e-mail two times. **To this date there has been no answer to his inquiry.**

MANY BIBLE TRANSLATIONS & VERSIONS

One reason that there is such confusion today concerning the “translation” of the Bible is that there are so many Bible versions. One of the causes for this multiplicity of Bible versions is the OTHER TEXTS that most translators use. Another reason is the method of translation known as dynamic equivalence. Today those *spurious Greek texts* are called **THE UNITED BIBLE SOCIETY GREEK TEXTS** and/or the **NESTLE/ALAND GREEK TEXTS**. Those *spurious texts* are from a completely different Greek foundation. Originally they were promoted by two men in the 1800's named **BISHOP BROOKE FOSS WESTCOTT** and **PROFESSOR FENTON JOHN ANTHONY HORT**. These are the heretical texts that these men promoted and used. These texts were lying around in places unread & unused. Yet because of them, all this Bible Version confusion has come. I really do not have time nor the knowledge to talk about all this, but learning it has been an EYE OPENER for me.

ARE CHURCH CONGREGATIONS TOO IGNORANT TO UNDERSTAND?

Sometimes it really offends me that some preachers think their congregations are too ignorant to understand that a translation is not “inspired” and that a translation is just that--a “translation.” It is *the originals* that are the *inspired* Words. The exact copies of those originals are copies of the *inspired words*. If I can understand this, anybody can. Yet, some missionaries and pastors will not take the truthful stand on translation and inspiration because they say their people will not comprehend it. They also infer that their financial support will dwindle if the truth were known that Bible versions, which are just translations done by men or women, are not “inspired.” **THE KING JAMES BIBLE IS AN EXCELLENT & ACCURATE TRANSLATION TRANSLATED FROM INSPIRED HEBREW, ARAMAIC, AND GREEK WORDS!**

DR. WAITE IN MINNEAPOLIS

That brought back a memory to me. When we were young people under the pastoral leadership of PASTOR GEORGE G. NIKA, our little Ohio church--out on a country road called Grayton Road--used to kneel during prayer meeting. I wonder whatever happened to that lovely custom! Now that property, where our little church used to be located, is part of the runways at HOPKINS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT in Cleveland, Ohio. My husband and I were married in that church 65 years ago this August (1948-2013).

PAST CANCER RECOVERY

Being the ages we are now, it is always a wonder if either one of us will go HOME TO BE WITH THE LORD while we are absent one from another. I don't think we are the only ones who think this way, but then, I don't go around asking either. This realization that we could part from one another in death, not only comes during absences because of travel; but it also come from serious illnesses and sicknesses that have come upon us in the past. We are aware that no one is immune from such illness.

Way back when Dr. Waite was fifty-six years of age (1985-86), he had Hodgkins Disease. My beautiful sister, Audrey June Sanborn, died from Hodgkins in 1952 at the age of twenty. I know from personal experience that there was no treatment for that cancer of the lymph glands at that time.

I am ever thankful to the Lord that my husband recovered from that dreaded disease. That was 27 years ago. I remember well when that *lump* was discovered on my husband's neck. We were on the way home, returning from taking our youngest son to college, and stopped by to see our daughter and her husband and family in Richmond. Our daughter looked at her father and asked, "What is that lump on your neck, Dad?" Thank God! He preserved him for further work. **That work has turned out to be the defense of the King James Bible and its underling Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek Words.** If God had called him HOME from that disease then, perhaps there would have been no book or cause called **DEFENDING THE KING JAMES BIBLE!** (BFT #1594 @ \$12.00 + \$8.00 S&H)

Then to finish the story (thus far), he had a minor stroke four months later on April 26, 2010. That was an interesting story but I think I have chatted about this too long and will save it to another time if it comes to mind then. (I've told you this before.) I must say, for a man who has had many major illnesses, he is able to carry on his daily schedule and many trips as if he were a much younger man instead of a senior citizen of 85 years of age. I cannot keep up with him! Of course, I am ten months older!
