MY HUSBAND BORN IN ELYRIA OHIO.

MY HUSBAND WAS BORN IN ELYRIA, OHIO, December 8, 1927, 88 YEARS AGO. AS A YOUNG GIRL, I LIVED IN THE SMALL NEIGHBORING COUNTRY TOWN OF LaGRANGE, OHIO. LATER, OUR FAMILIES BOTH MOVED TO BEREA, OHIO. Years later, we both graduated from Berea High school, which is closer to Cleveland. That was in 1945. No one much remembers us in Ohio. In fact, people—when they do inquire—are told that we have died already. And our "home" church—since Pastor Willetts passed on—never asks Dr. Waite to speak there anymore, or for me to portray FANNY CROSBY for them either for that matter. We are complete strangers at Berea Baptist Church except the pastor knows who we are. Berea Baptist began in my grandparents living room way back when. It was the church that ordained my husband to the gospel ministry. My father, R. O Sanborn, was active in moving the church family from the little building out by the airport to the then-newly-built education building on West Street.

The store proprietor near Dowagiac, Michigan, was a born-again Christian. Her name was CLAUDIA! The reason she has this lovely store is to tell her customers about the unsearchable riches of the Lord Jesus Christ. She was a treasure of a woman! BUT I FOUND ANOTHER TREASURE THERE! "GREEK IN BRIEF"
